\* Of the 54 tennis alerts, 15 were provided to the International Tennis Integrity Agency (ITIA) as intelligence reports as they do not relate to events sanctioned by the main tennis tours. However, some players engaged in those events may fall under the body's Tennis Anti-Corruption Program (TACP). Similarly, of the 22 table tennis alerts, 21 were reported on events not organised by the International Table Tennis Federation (ITTF).

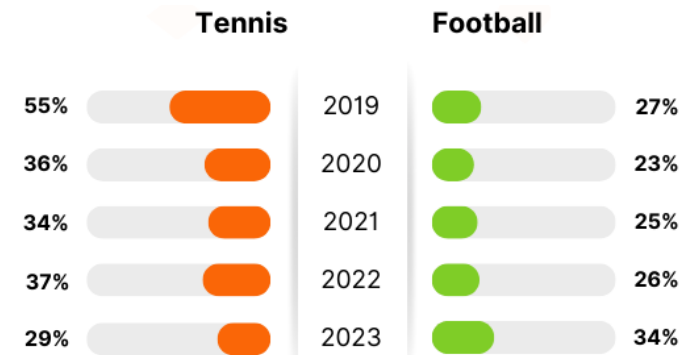
**Tennis** was the **second**
